Learn what is happening in current Chesapeake Bay Estuarine Research to add pizzazz to your environmental and ecology lessons.

- Study water quality and sample aquatic life in the Patuxent River.
- Work as a “scientist” beside an Academy Scientist on board the research vessel, the ***Joseph Leidy***, while dredging, using plankton tows, Ponar grabs, and fish trawls, etc.
- Get up close and personal with a marsh and explore what lives in the dark depths of the Patuxent River.
- Enhance instruction by developing lab activities for your classroom based on current research.
- Become Certified in “Project Wet”
- Earn seat hours (DC teachers), or 3 Continuing Professional Development Credits (Maryland Teachers) or three graduate credits from Towson University or Projects in Education/Trinity College.
